SUBJECT: **PY 2017 New WAP Awards – No Carryover**

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) Weatherization and Intergovernmental Program Office, (WIP) through the Weatherization Assistance Program (WAP), reminds all Grantees that new grant awards will be issued in Program Year 2017.

In the past four years, unexpended funds could be included in the next year's State Plan and put into the budget period as "carryover funds," within the same multi-year grant award. When new grants are issued in Program Year 2017, Grantees will not be allowed to carryover funds from previous awards. The new awards will follow the Financial Assistance regulations contained in 2 CFR 200 (with DOE regulations specific to for-profit organizations codified in 2 CFR 910).

WAP will be closing out the prior grant awards. WAP intends to de-obligate unexpended funds remaining from previous project periods 90 days after the end of the project period. The funds that have not been spent by Grantees will be added to the formula and dispensed to all WAP Grantees, subject to approval by the Office of Management and Budget.
